HISTORY WORKSHOP

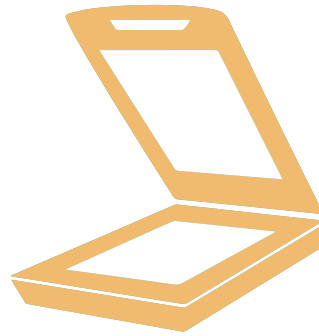

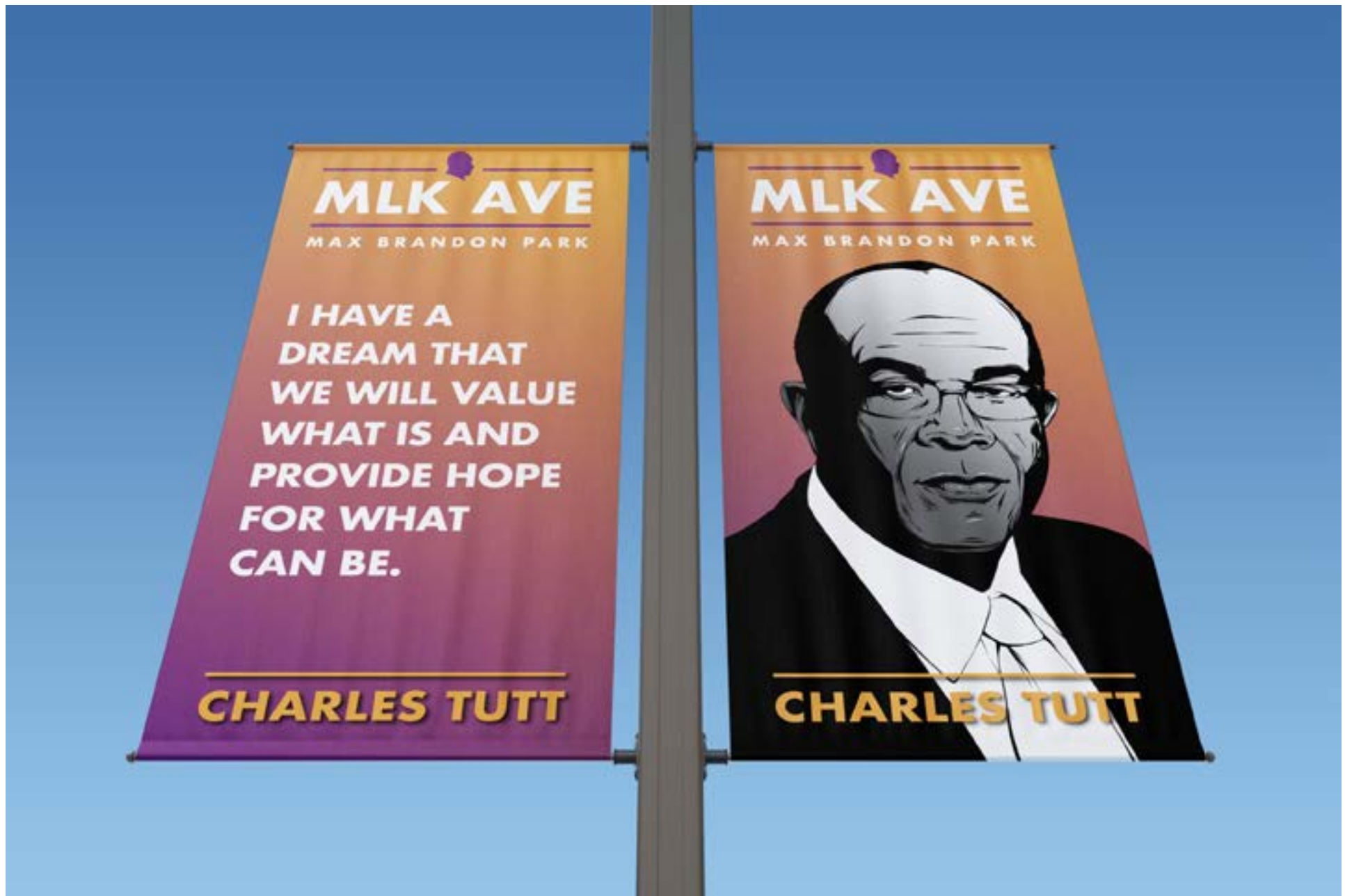

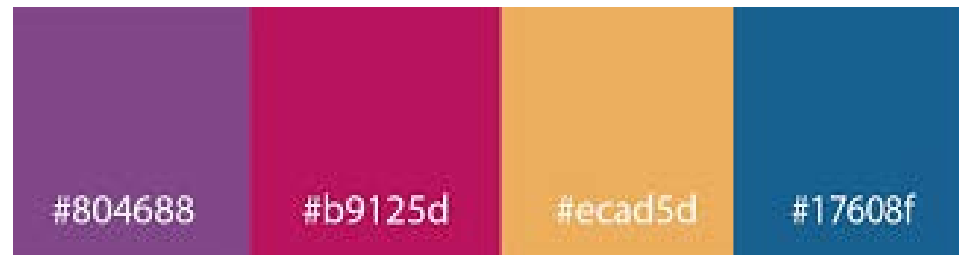


STREETSCAPING
